As an arbitrator, Jeff carefully studies submitted materials, gives witnesses and counsel his full attention and produces fair, well-reasoned decisions in a timely manner.

In addition to his service on the superior court beginning in 1991, Jeff was a trial lawyer and principal of a small Long Beach firm from 1981 until his appointment to the bench. From 1978 until 1981 he was a Los Angeles County deputy district attorney. His last assignment there was in Operation Hardcore, the elite gang murder unit. He is a 1978 graduate of Western State College of Law.

A former U.S. Marine, Jeff has been a *pro bono* advocate for veterans seeking disability services from the Veterans Administration. His military awards include the Marine Corps Combat Action Ribbon and the Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm.
